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INTRODUCTION

Thank you for your purchase of a Gared Sports model Micro-Z Portable backstop. To ensure that our equipment will provide years of use to you, we are including this installation, operation, and maintenance guide. This guide will provide information on the proper assembly and installation methods, operating procedures, and preventative maintenance of your portable backstop.

It is recommended that an individual who has been properly trained perform assembly and set up of the backstop. No one under the age of 18 should attempt assembly or set up of the unit, unless properly supervised.

To prevent normal wear and tear from shortening the life of the unit, preventative maintenance inspections and repairs should be performed at least once per year. If the units are subject to high or unusual usage, inspections should be scheduled to occur more frequently. If items are found to be nonconforming, replacements can be ordered from Gared Sports or one of our authorized dealers. When contacting Gared Sports, please have information regarding the dealer/installer who sold the unit, the name of the project, and any applicable warranty information.



WARNING!

Do not remove safety bolt before installing backboard and goal. Removing bolt could result in serious personal injury and/or damage to unit.

Recommended tools and accessories.



Step 2: Raise and secure main post.



Step3: Installing ballast.

- (A) Use appropriate screw driver or powered driver to remove side covers from base.
- (B) Attach bottom front pad.
- (C) Add weight to rear of base. Total weight should be:

260-320 lbs for MICRO-Z 300-360 lbs for MICRO-Z54 Patio Blocks shown, Paver Bricks, Sand Bags or other weights may also be used. Weight is not included with unit.

Step 4: Assemble backboard and extension boom.

*NOTE: Since goal, backboard and boom are connected with the same four bolts, it is suggested to pre-assemble all items on the floor as shown. Follow all notes in fig. 6 Leave bolts snug till step 5.



Step 5: Attach backboard to support post.





Step 7: Folding goal and slide post assembly for storage.

*NOTE: Please follow step by step procedure for best results.

- (A) Loosen 1/2" bolts at boom extension bracket.
- (B) Remove front bolt and rotate backboard assembly to down position.
- (C) Make sure the 5/16" bolt is in proper position for folding sequence by rotating key on bolt to keep board away from pad. See detail view.
- (D) Carefully rotate the slide post assembly to full down position. See fig. 10







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
