CHIEF OF DEFENCE STAFF

- ◆ General N. S. Raja Subramani officially started his role as India's Chief of Defence Staff on 31st May, 2026.
- ◆ The Chief of Defence Staff is the main military advisor to the Government of India and helps ensure that the Army, Navy and Air Force work together smoothly.
- ◆ As the highest-ranking military officer in the country, General Subramani is responsible for guiding key military reforms and improving how the three services operate together.
- ◆ His appointment is a significant step in India's efforts to modernise its defence system.
- ◆ General Subramani took over from General Anil Chauhan, who ended his term as Chief of Defence Staff on 30th May, 2026.
- ◆ During his time in the position, General Chauhan focused on strengthening military modernisation, promoting the development of indigenous defence capabilities and improving integrated military planning. The handover ensures that ongoing ma-



for defence projects continue without interruption.

About the Chief of Defence Staff

- ◆ The Chief of Defence Staff is the highest-ranking military officer in India and serves as the main military advisor to the Defence Minister.

Key Roles and Responsibilities

- ◆ **Single-Point Military Advice:** Gives advice to political leaders and the Defence Minister on all matters related to the three services.
- ◆ **Head of DMA:** Leads the Department of Military Affairs (DMA) within the Ministry of Defence, which helps with military procurement and budgeting.
- ◆ **Jointness & Integration:** Works to improve cooperation between the services and oversees the development of proposed integrated theatre commands.

- ◆ **Nuclear Command Authority:** Acts as the main military advisor to the Nuclear Command Authority.
- ◆ **No Field Command:** Works as a strategic and operational coordinator and holds a “first among equals” position with the service chiefs.

Past Chief of Defence Staff

- ◆ **General Bipin Rawat (2020–2021):** The first Chief of Defence Staff in India, who helped establish the role.
- ◆ **General Anil Chauhan (2022–2026):** Focused on improving integration between the services and boosting indigenous defence capabilities.

International News

- ◆ India has become the top performer in Global Remittance Inflows in 2024, with a record \$137.67 billion received.
- ◆ India ranks 157th out of 180 countries in the 2026 World Press Freedom Index by Reporters Without Borders, reflecting a historic low in global press freedom. The majority of the countries now fall into the “difficult” or “very serious” categories in the latest report.
- ◆ Yoweri Museveni has been sworn in for a seventh term as the President of Uganda. The 81-year-old leader first took office in 1986 and won the January 2026 presidential election.
- ◆ Myanmar’s President Min Aung Hlaing is set to visit India from 30 May to 3 June, 2026.
- ◆ Shrey Parikh, an Indian-origin student, has won the Scripps National Spelling Bee 2026 title.
- ◆ The United Nations added Israel to its Conflict-Related Sexual Violence Watchlist.
- ◆ India became Sri Lanka’s second-largest export destination in 2026, surpassing the United Kingdom.
- ◆ Kevin Warsh has taken the oath as the new U.S. Federal Reserve Chair, replacing Jerome Powell.
- ◆ India has signed a strategic partnership deal with Cyprus that covers defence, trade and cybersecurity.
- ◆ A deadly coal mine explosion in China’s Shanxi province killed at least 90 people.
- ◆ India and Ethiopia formally signed a Bilateral Market Access Protocol on May 22, 2026, in Geneva, advancing Ethiopia’s ongoing accession process to the World Trade Organization (WTO).
- ◆ India postponed the Fourth India-Africa Forum Summit in New Delhi due to an ongoing Ebola health emergency in Africa.
- ◆ India has overtaken the U.S. to become Bangladesh’s second-largest trading partner.
- ◆ Russian President Vladimir Putin will attend the BRICS Summit 2026 in New Delhi in September.
- ◆ Nepal’s climbers Kami Rita Sherpa and Lhakpa Sherpa have broken their own records by reaching Mount Everest’s summit for the 32nd and 11th time, respectively.
- ◆ U.S. President Donald Trump and China’s Xi Jinping concluded high-level talks in Beijing with positive comments, although few concrete deals were announced.
- ◆ India and the UAE signed seven major agreements during Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s visit to Abu Dhabi, covering areas like defence, energy security, AI supercomputing, shipbuilding, workforce skills and a \$5 billion investment commitment.

- ◆ The Kimberley Process Intersessional 2026 meeting was held in Mumbai under India's chairmanship, focusing on transparency, responsible sourcing and trust in the diamond industry globally.
- ◆ The Taliban has signed a \$46 million deal with the Indian company TCRC to build customs labs across Afghanistan. The project aims to modernise trade systems, improve quality standards and boost technical skills, but transparency and implementation remain concerns.
- ◆ India's passport ranks 78th in the 2026 Henley Passport Index, granting access to 56 destinations. This affects travel, visa rules and global mobility for Indian citizens.
- ◆ India is planning a subsea gas pipeline project worth ₹40,000 crore from Oman to Gujarat to enhance energy security amid disruptions caused by the 2026 Strait of Hormuz crisis.
- ◆ International Olympic Committee lifts restrictions on Belarusian Athletes.
- ◆ Saudi Arabia has joined the International Big Cat Alliance as a new member.
- ◆ The 79th World Health Assembly was held in Geneva, Switzerland.
- ◆ UAE exits from OPEC and OPEC+ from 1 May, 2026.
- ◆ India has dominated the Asia University Rankings 2026; IISc Bengaluru ranks 43rd.

- ◆ RBI has approved Kotak Mahindra Bank to raise its stake in AU SFB and Federal Bank.
- ◆ The Finance Ministry has allowed 100 per cent FDI in the Insurance Sector under the Automatic Route.
- ◆ Axis Bank has launched the First Digital Locker-Focused Branch in New Delhi.
- ◆ ZikZuk Technologies has received RBI approval to operate as a Prepaid Payment Instrument Issuer.
- ◆ RBI has approved a record ₹2.86 lakh crore surplus transfer to the government for FY 2025-26.

- ◆ The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed monetary penalties totaling ₹15.90 lakh on City Union Bank, Mintifi Finserve, and Newa Investments for non-compliance with regulatory and governance directions.
- ◆ SBI Mutual Fund increased its stake in Bandhan Bank to 5.0432% after acquiring nearly 1.7 million additional shares through open market transactions on May 20, 2026. This latest purchase brought their total cumulative holding to 81,246,734 shares, up from below the 5% mark.
- ◆ AI-powered fintech app jUMPP has officially secured Corporate Agency and Insurance Self Network Platform (ISNP) licences from the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) to digitally distribute insurance products through its platform.
